RECOMMENDED HANDLING

When you receive your Dawn Frozen Products, place your cases immediately into a 0° degree F (zero) or below freezer.
REMOVE only the amount of product that will be used. Close the case and return the remaining product to the freezer immediately.

Make - up Directions:

- REMOVE product from the freezer.
- PLACE Beignets evenly spaced in a single layer on a donut screen.
- Cover Beignets with parchment paper to prevent skin from forming.
- LET covered Beignets stand at room temperature for 30 minutes.
- REMOVE parchment paper before frying.
- FRY at 325° degrees F. for 2 minutes on each side. Upon initially placing in fryer - Hold screen in fryer for 5 seconds - then lower screen to allow Beignets to float and not sink.
- REMOVE from fryer and drain. Let cool for 2 minutes.
- PLACE Beignets on a lined sheet pan and coat all sides with desired topping such as: Donut Coating Sugar.
- FREEZER LIFE: 150 days from manufacture**
